SPEAKERS

JOSEPH A. PIPA, JR.

Dr. Pipa is President and Professor of Historical and Systematic Theology at Greenville Presbyterian Theological Seminary. He received his B.A. from Belhaven College, his M.Div. from Reformed Theological Seminary and his Ph.D. from Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia. He has pastored churches in Houston and Escondido, CA., and has taught and lectured at various seminaries in the USA. He is the author and editor of numerous books, including *Root & Branch*, *The Lord's Day* and *Written for our Instruction: The Sufficiency of Scripture for All of Life*. Dr. Pipa has been a guest speaker at other Sola Scriptura conferences.

MICHAEL A.G. HAYKIN

Dr. Haykin has a B.A. in Philosophy from the University of Toronto, a M.Rel. from Wycliffe College, the University of Toronto, and a Th.D. in Church History from Wycliffe College and the University of Toronto. Dr. Haykin serves as Professor of Church History and Biblical Spirituality at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary in Louisville, Kentucky. He is also the director of The Andrew Fuller Center for Baptist Studies. He has written and edited numerous books, including: *The empire of the Holy Spirit*, *The advent of Evangelicalism*, *The Christian Lover*, *The God who draws near*, *Jonathan Edwards: The Holy Spirit in revival*.

HEINZ DSCHANKILIC

Heinz Dschankilic has been with Sola Scriptura since 1999 and stepped into the director's role in 2002. He holds an Honours B.Th. from Central Baptist Seminary and was a contributing author to *A foundation for life: A study of key Christian doctrines and their application* (Joshua Press). His passion for theological education has been expressed both as a conference speaker as well as a contributing author for Particular Baptist Press, Joshua Press and *The Gospel Witness*.
